# ACTIVITIES

*These are just some of the activities we can arrange for you here, on-site at Poinciana:*

## Balinese Offering Making Class

Discover the meaning behind Bali's beautiful daily offerings and create your own canang sari from fresh flowers, palm leaves and incense, guided by our local Balinese team. **Rp. 300,000 / person**



## Balinese Cooking Class

Learn to prepare traditional Balinese dishes using fresh local ingredients and authentic recipes – from grinding spices to the final plate. **Rp. 350,000 / person**

## Balinese Dance Lesson

Learn the graceful hand movements, expressive eyes and rhythmic steps of traditional Balinese dance with a local instructor. No experience needed. **Rp. 250,000 / person**



## Traditional Fishing

Head out to sea on a traditional jukung boat right from Poinciana beach and learn local fishing techniques while enjoying the calm waters of the North Bali coast. **Rp. 500,000 / person**

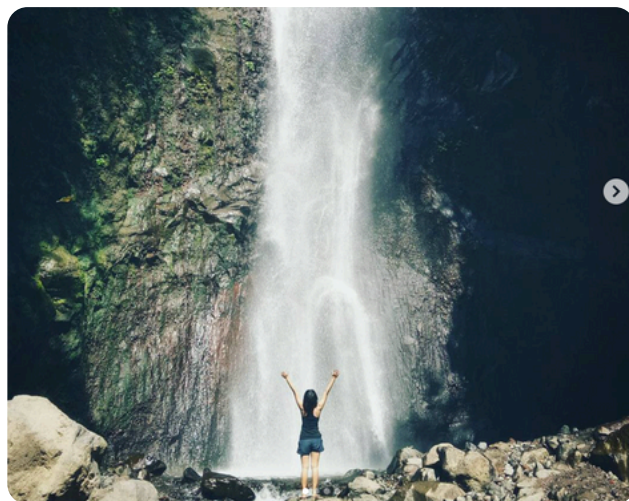

# EXCURSIONS

*We have several excursions in the area that can be done either in the morning or in the afternoon, or as a combination for a whole day excursion.*



## Ponjok Batu Temple

located in the village of Pacung, approximately 25 minutes west of Poinciana, this sacred temple is entirely made of stone and situated on a cliff top overlooking the sea. Built in the 16th century, Ponjok Batu temple is one of Bali's seven sacred sea temples. During its renovation in 1995, a sarcophagus believed to date back to 300BC, was discovered at the site.

## Yeh Mampeh Les Waterfall

A 2km hike takes you through plantations and jungle to experience the power of this natural wonder. Though it's not deep enough to swim, it's one of the few waterfalls in Bali you can stand under. So bring your bathing suit and a camera. As it's also one of the lesser-known waterfalls in Bali, you are likely to be the only ones there. ***Rp. 600,000 / vehicle max 3, includes admission***

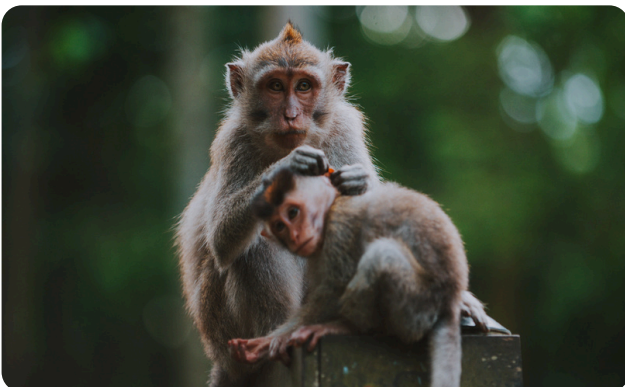
## Sunrise Boat Trip

Take a traditional jukung (boat) to join the dolphins for a spectacular sunrise off the North Coast. Spotted dolphins, spinner dolphins and bottle nosed dolphins are among the species in the area. It's a 5.30am start right from the beach at Poinciana. Return time is before breakfast, so it leaves the rest of the day free for other activities. **Rp. 350,000 / person**



## Muntigunung Trekking

Come and discover the Bali wilderness and help the community at the same time. The Eco trekking project was created to help the 35 communities be self-sustainable in an area of the island that is drought stricken for 8 months of the year and unsuitable for development or agriculture. If you're looking for an eco-tour, this is it. **Please ask at the reception for the current price.**



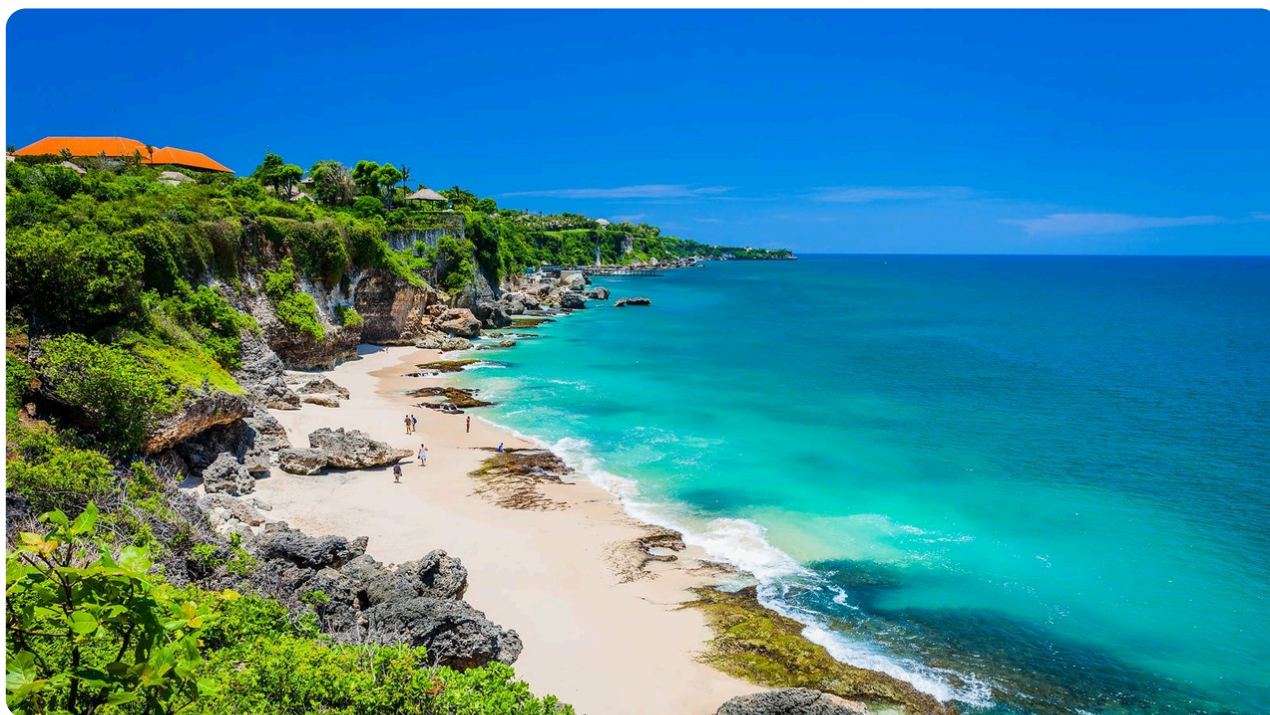


# DAY TOURS

*We have a wide range of tours that can be done with a start or end point from anywhere on the island. All day tours are 6-8 hours unless otherwise noted. For more information, pricing and to find out how we can fully customize a day tour for you, come to reception.*

*All activities and excursions must be booked 24 hours in advance and day tours must be booked at least 8 hours in advance unless otherwise noted. If there is something you want to do that you don't see here, come and talk to us to find out how we can customize your Bali experience.*

## South Bali Tour

Built in the 15th Century, Tanah Lot is one of Bali's 7 sacred sea temples. Then it's off to Uluwatu where you can watch the surfers ride the waves from a spectacular cliff-top viewpoint. Then see a Kecak & Fire dance before heading to watch the sunset from Jimbaran beach, famous for its seafood and candle lit tables right on the sand. Dinner not included.

## Bedugul Tour

See Git-Git waterfall and visit the Bedugul traditional market, also known as the Gunung Bedugul Temple Market, with its fruit and vegetables provided by local farmers in the area. Then it's on to see the Pacung rice terrace and stop for lunch (not included). The last stop is Pura Ulun Danu, named after the water Goddess Danu, and also known as the floating temple.

## Water Palace Tour

Completed in 1919 by the last King and destroyed by a Mt. Agung eruption, the Ujung Water Palace was rebuilt in 2004 and overlooks beautiful gardens and the Lombok Strait. The same King built Tirta Gangga, which enables visitors to walk through the water gardens on stepping stones. There is a separate pool for bathing and swimming in the holy spring water. Lunch (not included) can be arranged before or after the visit to Tirta Gangga in one of the surrounding restaurants or warungs (local restaurants).

## Munduk Tour

Explore Bali at higher altitude and take a scenic drive through traditional villages to soak up the breathtaking landscape of the Munduk area. You will also visit Munduk waterfall and have the chance to marvel at the beauty & engineering of the spectacular rice terraces that Bali is famous for.

## Ubud Tour

The Ubud tour starts with a tour of the coffee plantation and your chance to experience 'Kopi Luwak,' the most unique coffee in the world. Then you'll go to Tegallalang rice terraces, followed by the famed Ubud monkey forest, then a stop at the Ubud market for some shopping or browsing. **Rp. 1,200,000 / vehicle, max 3 people**



## Banjar Tour

See the largest Buddhist temple in Bali. Then immerse yourself in the therapeutic hot springs of Banjar village. **Rp. 1,200,000 / vehicle, max 3 people**

## Batur Volcano Trek

Trek up the volcano with an experienced guide to watch the sun rise over the stunning landscape. Leave the resort at 2:00am. **Rp. 2,000,000/vehicle, incl transport & guide, max 2**
